

Packaging your English course with Le Cordon Bleu Australia

Students who apply to study English with Hawthorn-Melbourne prior to their course at Le Cordon Bleu Australia may be eligible for a packaged visa. Packaged visas are a great way to reduce the time and costs involved in applying for visas.

The process outlined below explains how to package your studies with Hawthorn-Melbourne and Le Cordon Bleu Australia.

Step 1:

Apply to Le Cordon Bleu Australia

- •Send your completed application form to the Le Cordon Bleu Australia admissions team.
- •If your application is successful, Le Cordon Bleu Australia will issue a Letter of Offer conditional on meeting the English language requirements.

Step 2:

Apply to Hawthorn-Melbourne

- •Send you Letter of Offer from Le Cordon Bleu Australia to Hawthorn-Mellbourne with a completed application form for the English course.
- •If available, include a copy of the student's IELTS, TOEFL or other approved English test results.
- •Applicants without a formal assessment of their English level can take our online placement test¹.
- Hawthorn-Melbourne will issue a Letter of Offer for the English course.

Step 3: Confirm your enrolment with HawthornMelbourne

- •Confirm your enrolment with Hawthorn-Melbourne by following the steps outlined in your Letter of Offer.
- Hawthorn-Melbourne will send you a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) for your English course.

Step 4: Confirm your enrolment with Le Cordon Bleu Australia

- •Send a copy of the Hawthorn-Melbourne CoE to Le Cordon Bleu Australia
- •Le Cordon Bleu Australia will send you an CoE for your course

Step 5: Apply for your visa

Apply for your student visa using both the CoEs
